A suspended student may petition for readmission to the Huizenga School after a period of one year from term of suspension. The student must appeal for readmission in writing to the Office of Admissions at least 30 days prior to the first day of the term in which they wish to enroll. Each petition must include a readmission fee (nonrefundable, see Catalog/Table of Contents for Student Fees).

In the petition, the student should state the reasons why academic potential has improved since suspension. The petition itself should reflect the student's ability to communicate effectively; and include proper spelling and grammar to meet minimum standards required in graduate-level education. Petitions containing poor grammar, misspellings, and sub-standard writing quality will result in automatic and final denial of readmission.

A notification letter will be sent to the student indicating readmission status. The student may contact an academic advisor for information on the appeals process or a pending appeal.
